





volution of national, and foreigners physicians ratio by 100,000 Inhabitants, 2010-2016





Evolution of the national MCHN ratio by 100,000 women in fertile age (15-49 years) and children from 0-5 years, 2010-2016








Evolution of the annual rates of losses reported in the sector, 2010-2016




Evolution of the national staff of the





KEY CONCLUSIONS

- Mozambique is accomplishing progresses with the increase of human resources for health in general. From 2010 to 2016 the effective of national HHR grew in 56%;
- The ratio of health technicians has been registering improvements. The ratio of national and foreigner physicians per 100,000 inhabitants has gone up from 4,7 in 2010 to 7,7 in 2016, the one of nurses has gone up from 24,0 in 2010 to 28,8 in 2016, while the one of MCHN has gone up from 44,0 in 2010 to 50,4 in 2016;
- There is reduction of the health special regime staff of the elentary and basic levels, and na increase in the medium and superior levels during the period under analysis. In 2010, out of the total health special regime staff 10% were of the elementary level, 51% of the basic level, 32% of the medium level, and 7% of the superior level, towards 4%, 26%, 56% and 14% for the elementary, basic, medium and superior levels, respectively, in 2016;
- The workforce is equilibrated in terms of gender, with a trend to increase the females, which percentage in 2010 was 52,1, and in 2013 was 54,8;

The number of graduates has gone up in 14% from 2010 to 2016.
